

Komodo Dive & Explore

(4 nights | July to September)

Designed to showcase some of the highlights of Komodo including the chance to see the famous Komodo Dragon in its natural habitat. Then there are the beautiful beaches, lookouts to climb, a range of water sports such as paddle boarding, kayaking and snorkelling and some easy diving to experience paradise both below and above the water.

This itinerary allows for 2 dives per day for qualified divers whilst non-divers have the chance to experience an 'Introductory Dive'. Our experienced guides will select the best spots to dive, snorkel and swim in each location and to suit local conditions, marine life opportunities and your experience.

Port of Embarkation: Labuan Bajo (Komodo Airport)

Highlights may include but are not limited to:

Day 1

In the morning we'll meet you in Labuan Baja and travel to Central Komodo where you'll get a chance to paddle board, kayak or snorkel in the beautiful coral gardens of Siaba, Sebayor or Sebolang. The boat will then move to the Wainilu area at Rinca for a sunset diner and possibly see flying fruits bats.

Qualified divers: 1 Check Dive in the area and night dive.

Day 2

An early start for a trek with Komodo dragons before the boat moves to Pink Beach for snorkelling, beach relaxation and swimming. After lunch, the boat heads for the world famous Padar Island for water activities and trekking up to see the sunset. While at Padar we offer non-divers the chance to do a short 'Introduction Dive'.

Qualified divers: Depending on tides and current, the possibility to dive in the Pink Beach area and another dive in Padar.

Komodo National Park Fee & Dragon entrance is charged extra at \$25 per person.

Day 3

Early morning the boat will move to Gili Lawa Laut for water or land activities such as paddle boarding, drift snorkelling, taking a walk on land or just relaxing on the beach.

Qualified divers: 2 dives in Gili Lawa depending on tides and current.

Day 4

The boat will leave Gili Lawa Laut early morning to get a beautiful view of an active volcano in Sangeang while having breakfast. Water activities are available all morning and a visit to the Bonto traditional village can be arranged. The boat will move during lunch time aiming to be in Banta around coffee time. In Banta Bay you can enjoy snorkelling, trekking or enjoying a sunset cocktail before dinner.

Qualified divers: 2 dives are possible whilst observing no diving 24 hours before your flight. Dives are dependent on tides and current.

Day 5 While you sleep, the boat will leave very early back to Labuan Bajo for check out at 10 am.
